

Targets for 2016/17 and beyond

We are in the process of signing off a set of three long term aspirations, or stretching goals, which are aligned to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals. These will help drive innovation, inspire our employees, provide opportunity to engage with customers, build a resilient business and ultimately deliver positive economic, environmental and social outcomes. We will be in a position to publicise these shortly and, over the next financial year, will be developing medium and shorter term targets to meet them. Until then we have a number of ongoing targets towards which we will continue to work.

- Improve carbon emissions intensity by a further 50% from a 2012/13 baseline for property under our direct control (by 31 March 2022).
- To effectively realise value from the natural resources of the UK seabed, including facilitation of 8-10 GW of operational offshore wind capacity (by 31 March 2020).
- Achieve BREEAM 'excellent' rating on all completed, commercial office projects overseen by the Development team (ongoing).
- 50% of SSSIs on the rural and Windsor estates in England will be in 'favourable' condition, while maintaining at least 95% in 'favourable or recovering' condition, in line with the Government target (2020).
- Zero operational waste to landfill where we have control (ongoing).
- Reuse or recycle 90% of non-hazardous waste from all new build and major refurbishment projects overseen by the Development team (ongoing).
- Overall H&S incident score to be reduced by 10% (ongoing).
- Recruit London to achieve 90 jobs within the West End (by 31 March 2017).
